

REGULATION OF BATHING AND OF THE OPERATION OF THE CAMPSITE

- 1./ The beach is open limited, daily from 9 am - till 19 pm.
Shore based rescue is only provided in this period.
You are advised to bathe only in the period indicated. The responsibility of bathing after the opening hours lies upon the bather. In accordance with the rules of the campsite parents are responsible for their children.
Bathing at night is strictly prohibited.
- 2./ The depth of the water measured at the border buoys of the bathing area: 120 centimetres.
- 3./ You are not allowed to take animals with you to the beach.
- 4./ No fishing in the designated bathing area.
- 5./ According to point g, section 2 of order 46/2001. of the Ministry of Interior it is forbidden to bathe further than 500 metres far from the shore. Observing the above order the designated bathing area of our beach exclusively extends to the border buoys, bathing further than those is strictly forbidden.
- 6./ Children under 6 years, and children of 12 years unable to swim can only bathe in lakes and rivers under an adult's direct control. (point (1) of section 3 of 46/2001. of Ministry of Interior)
- 7./ In case of a group of children or of youngsters the leader of the group needs to set a suitable number (depending on the number of children in the group) of adult guards on duty, who can swim and are experienced in life-saving. (Point (2), section 3 of order 46/2001 of the Ministry of Interior)
- 8./ A storm-warning system forecasting and signalling storms is operated from the 1st May to the 30th September. Operation is detailed in a separate table.

Further orders:

- 9./ No entry for vehicles to the beach.
- 10./ You can bathe and lie in the sun, do other usual sports on the beach, but activities disturbing the ones beforehand and the comfort of the other clients are not allowed. Activities disturbing and damaging the beach and its environment are also prohibited.
- 11./ On the beach everybody is obliged to take care of his/her health or that of the other bathers. Every one is to gauge the emergency or the situation and have to decide to bathe or not.
- 12./ It is dangerous and strictly forbidden to jump into the water from the bathing platform and from the stones on the shore.
- 13./ The beach cannot be used by:
 - People who have fever, gastric complaints, problems with their intestine or any skin disease,
 - People having illnesses with violent fits and causing unconsciousness, (epilepsy, Parkinson disease, neurotic diseases etc.)
 - People having a lesion of great extent,
 - Drunk or stoned people.(drinking too much alcohol or taking different drugs)

Regulation of operation:

- 14./ The capacity of the beach is 700 persons.
- 15./ The bathers can use the washrooms and toilets of the campsite nearest to the beach.
 - The washrooms and toilets are open all day. The bathers are obliged to use these. Cold water wash-basins can be found in the washrooms and toilets.
 - These rooms are continuously cleaned and disinfected, the chairpersons clean these rooms, keeping and respecting the hygienic orders.
 - Although the water in the washrooms and toilets is drinkable, it is strictly forbidden to draw water in the toilets.
- 16./ There is a first-aid station on the beach, a first-aid outfit is available.
- 17./ The water police and further orders stated in this regulation (points 1-13) refer to all the bathers without any exception, and the beach can only be used on one's own responsibility and keeping the orders mentioned above.
